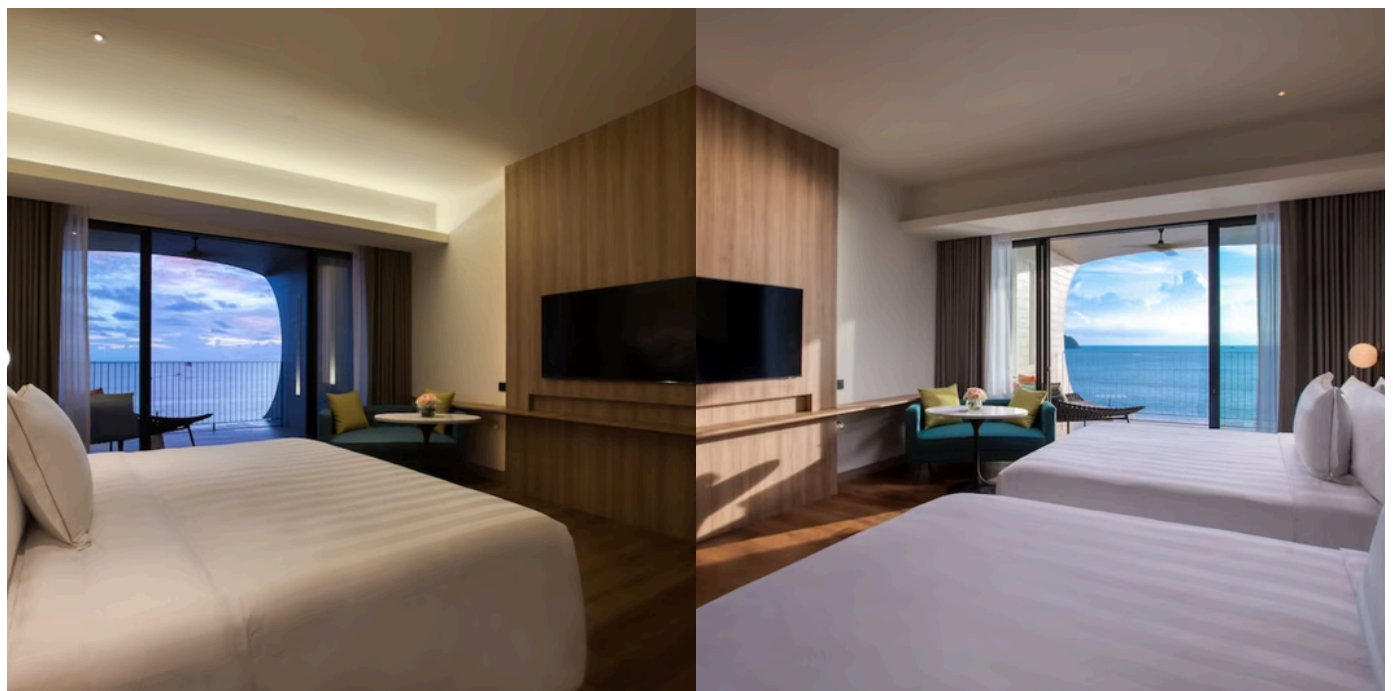

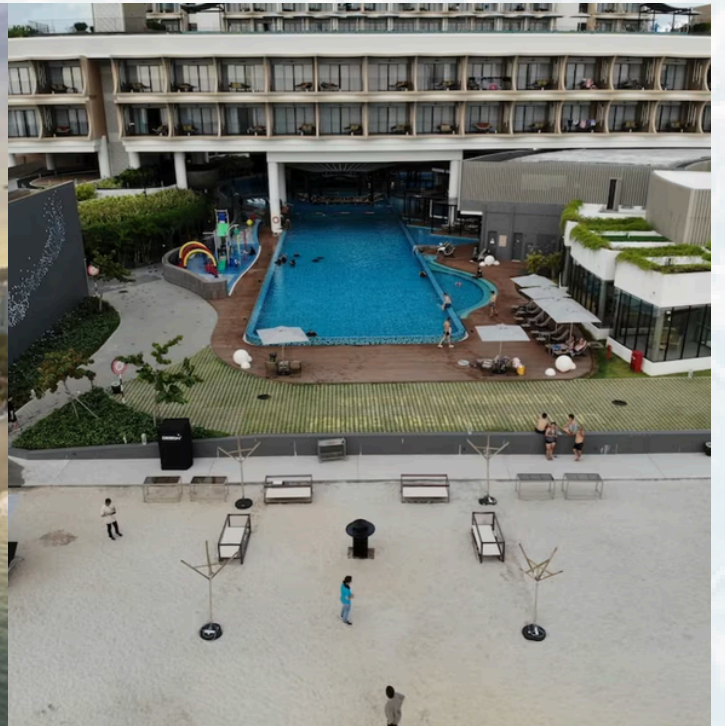

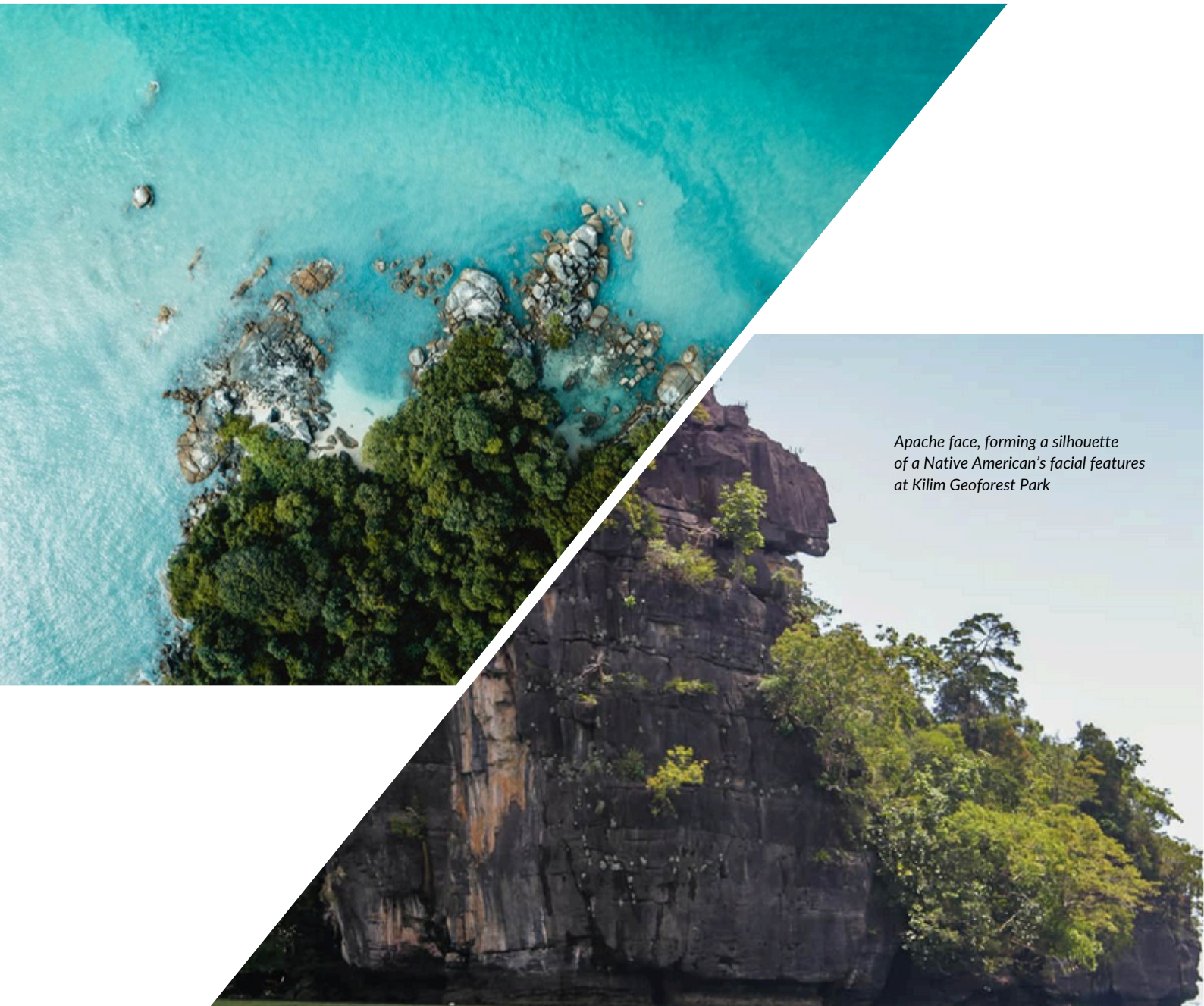

About Langkawi Island

- Langkawi Island, officially known as Langkawi, the Jewel of Kedah, is a district and an archipelago of 99 islands (plus 5 small islands visible only at low tide) in the Andaman Sea, situated approximately 30 km off the mainland coast of northwestern Malaysia. The 99 islands are a part of the state of Kedah, which is adjacent to the Thailand border.
- In 2007, Langkawi was awarded the UNESCO Global Geopark status, becoming the first Global Geopark in Southeast Asia. Langkawi UNESCO Global Geopark comprises Machincang Cambrian Geoforest Park, Kilim Karst Geoforest Park, Dayang Bunting Marble Geoforest Park, and Kubang Badak BioGeo Trail.
